Dear Adopter,

As of 31 December 2008, DCP, LLC will no longer accept new submissions for Approved Retransmission Technologies (ARTs). ARTs were created as a stop-gap measure to meet an industry need for distribution of high-definition content over low bandwidth interfaces since HDCP 1.x does not support distribution of compressed content. With the release of the HDCP 2.0 specification for IP and WHDI (with more interfaces planned for the future), there is no longer a need for the ART process.

Current approved ARTs will continue to be listed in the HDCP License Agreement, and any ART submission received before 31 December 2008 will be accepted, and pending approval, will be added to the License Agreement as well. However, the focus of implementations going forward will be the utilization of HDCP 2.0.
